This unique perennial forage grass combines high yield potential with outstanding nutritional value to provide an excellent pasture for sheep, dairy or beef production.

Combining good resistance to rust and other diseases with excellent germination and seedling vigor and fast recovery after cutting or grazing. Kemal is ideal in mixed pastures containing white clover or subclover.
